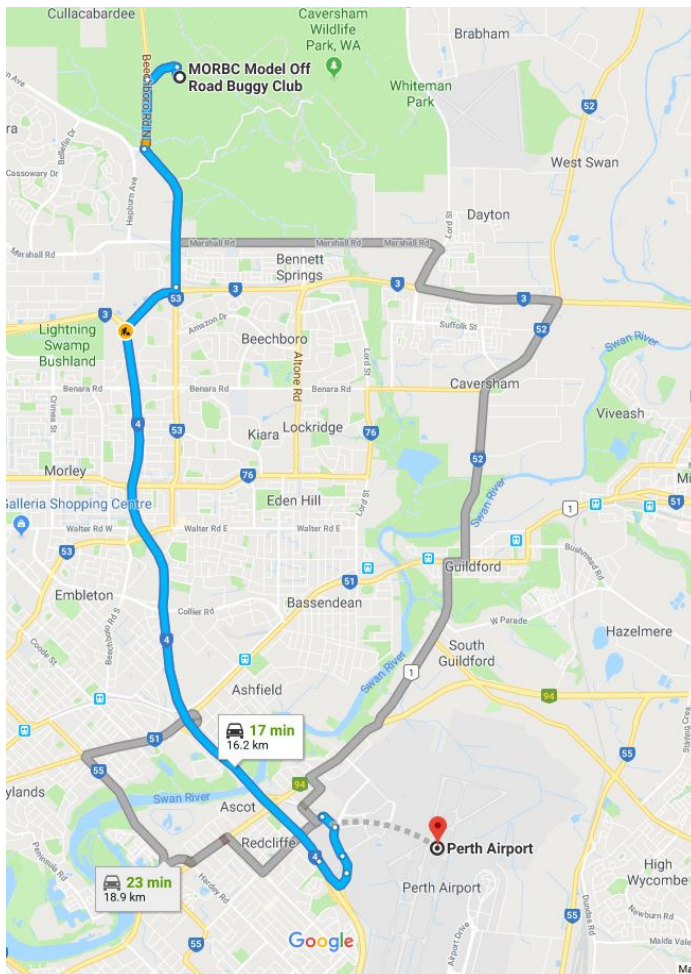

Timing system will be LiveRC main and a backup as well, results will be posted here <https://morbc.liverc.com/>

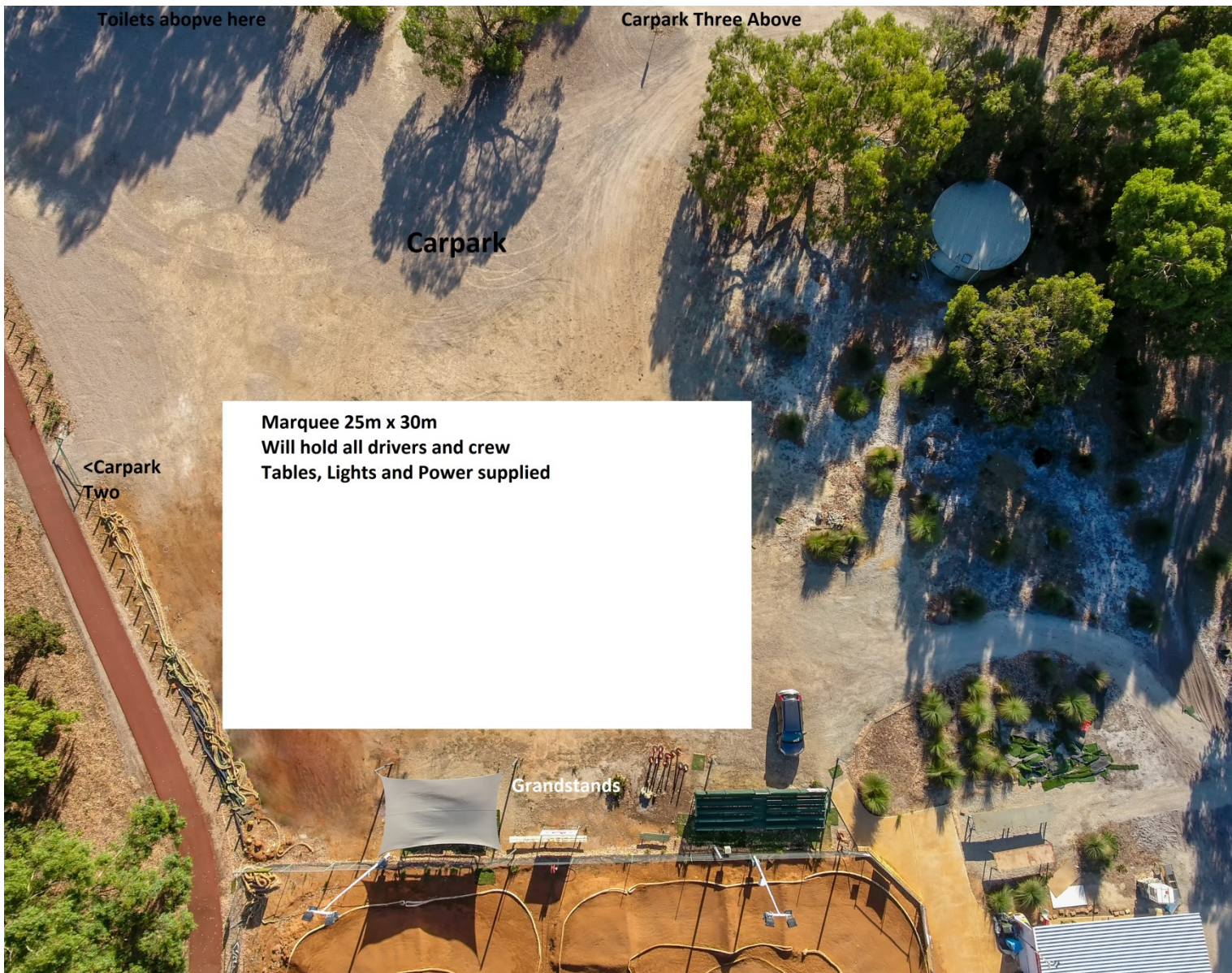


A second internet feed for the media will be available limited speed as we only can get WI-FI at the track.

Pitting we will have over 280 pitting spots available at the track, 200 will be in a 25m x 30m marquee and 80 in our normal undercover pitting area and all will have 240v power supply. No other pitting are is available. **We have a wash down area with both water and air supply**
