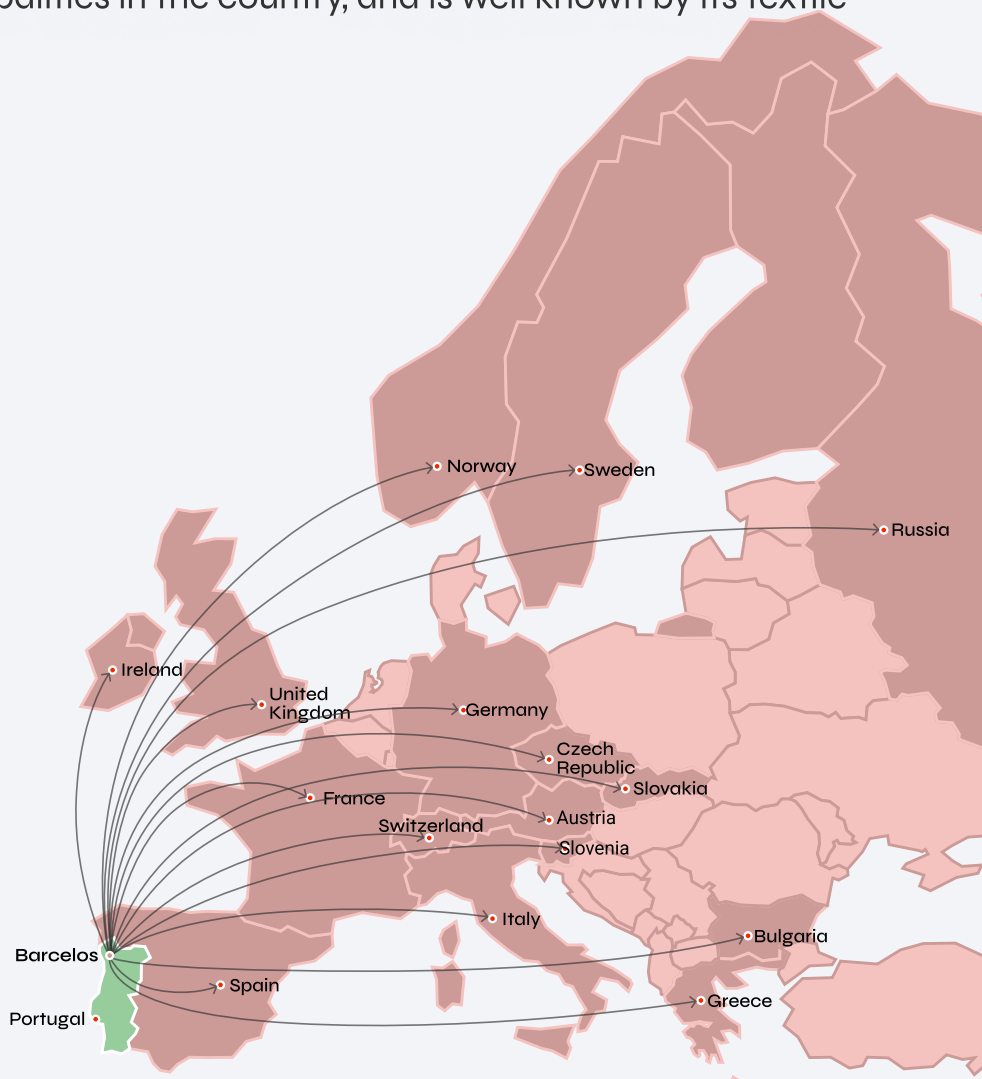




Barcelos is a city and a municipality in Braga District in the Minho Province, in the north of Portugal. The population in 2021 was 116,777, in an area of 378.90 km². With 86 parishes, it is the municipality with the highest number of parishes in the country. It is one of the growing municipalities in the country, and is well known by its textile and adobe industries.

Originally a Roman settlement, it expanded and became the seat of the First Duke of Bragança in the 15th century. The palace of the Dukes of Bragança was destroyed by an earthquake in 1755 and is now an open-air museum.

Barcelos is part of the UNESCO Creative Cities Network as a Crafts and Folk Art City.



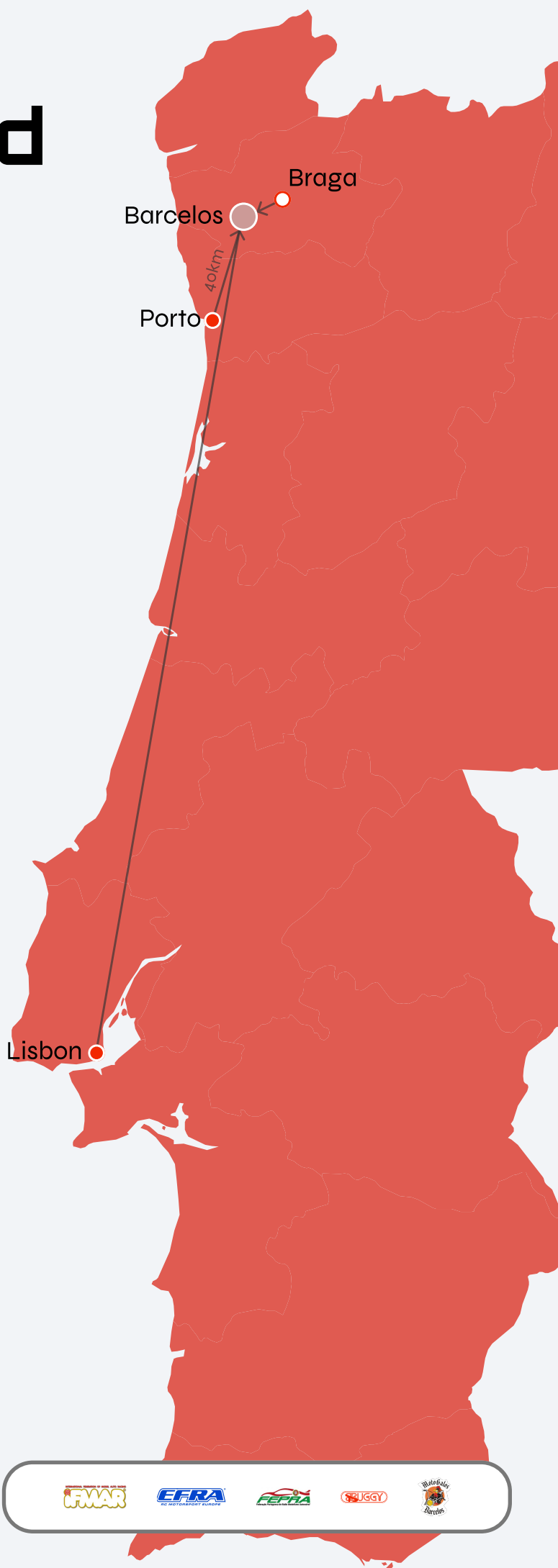
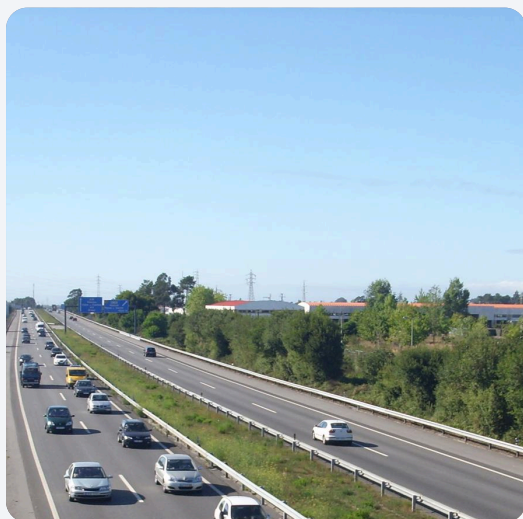
Barcelos is a city located in the north of Portugal,

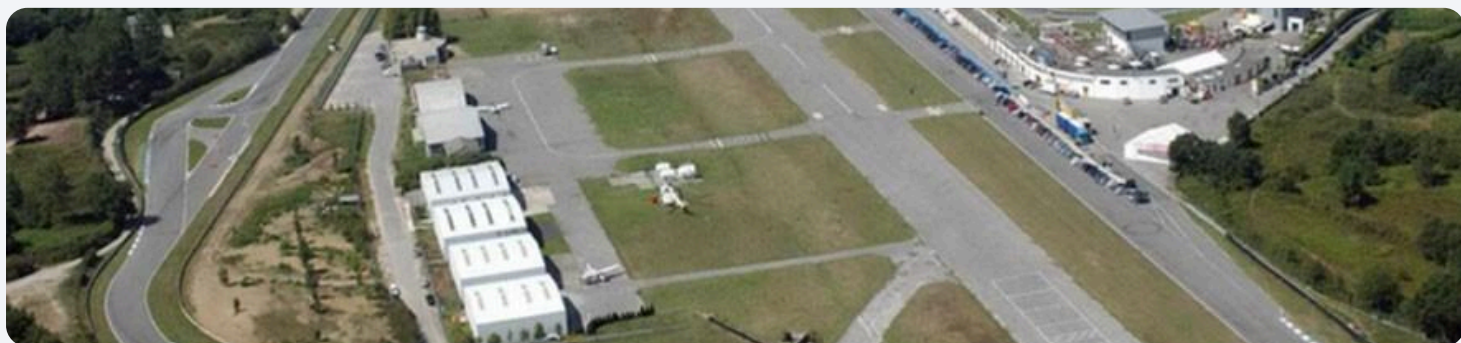

According to a study presented by the prestigious French magazine KartMag, the Kartdromo Internacional de Braga is the seventh best kart track in international terms, and has already received several races of the world championship, having passed through KIB riders such as Lewis Hamilton or Fernando Alonso.

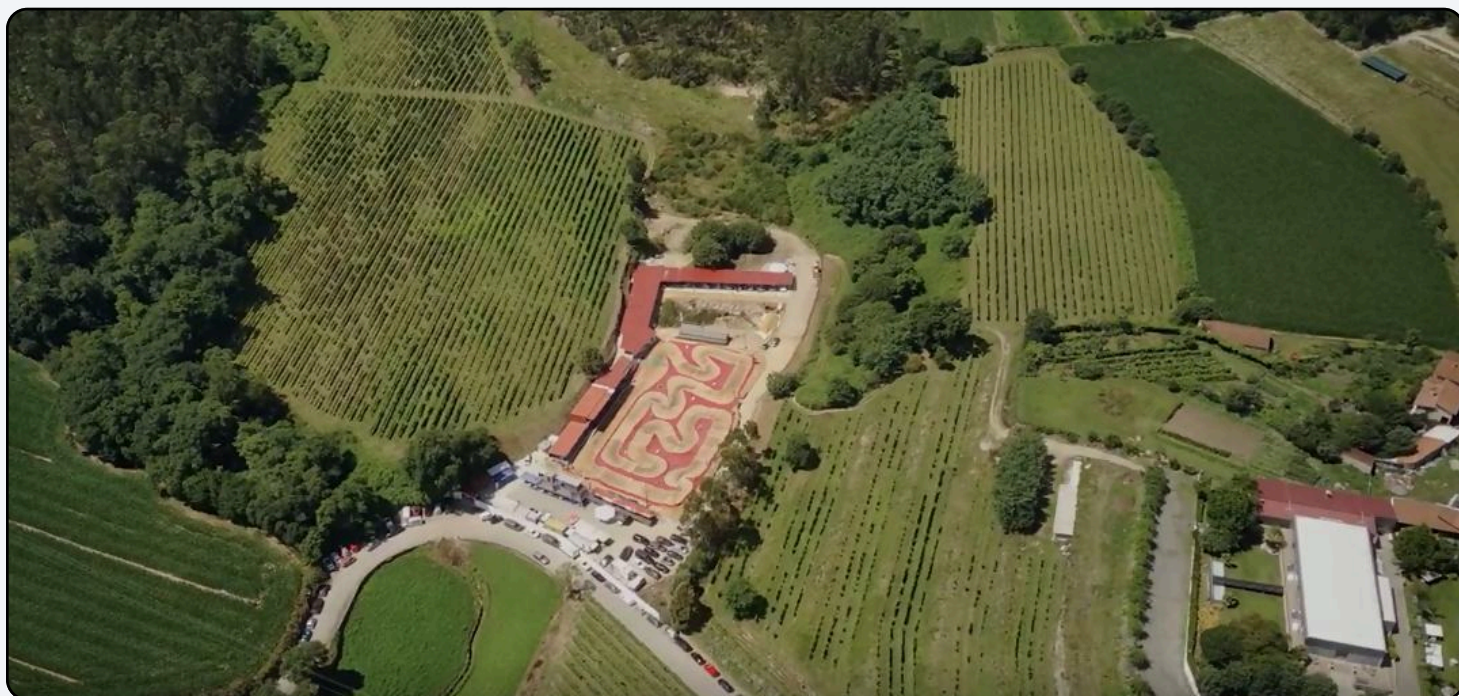
With a perimeter of 1,286 meters and 17 curves, it is a circuit where it is necessary to combine technique with pure speed.

The Vasco Sameiro circuit, also known as the Circuito Internacional de Braga, was built in 1990, and was inaugurated in 1993. It is travelled counter clockwise, with a perimeter of 3020 meters and 13 curves.
